An organization with which swine men may well affiliate is the National Swine Growers' Association, Chicago, Illinois. This association is organized and maintained for the promotion of the swine industry. Membership may consist of any person, firm, corporation, or association, that is engaged in the breeding, raising, selling, or improvement of swine. Fees are nominal, and a copy of the by-laws may be obtained by writing to the secretary.

There are also special state and breed associations that are particularly interested in the promotion of different breeds of swine, as well as the swine industry. These are organized for the promotion and benefit of swine interests specific and general.
