Stephanie Bennett has been named special collections and archives collections archivist at Wake Forest University. She was previously project archivist at Iowa State University.

Tony Crawford retired in January 2015 after holding positions as university archivist and curator of manuscripts

at the Morse Department of Special Collections at Kansas State University for 31 years. He was employed as the first official university archivist in 1983 and led the effort to create the institution's first records retention schedule. Among his accomplishments as curator of manuscripts was the formation of the Consumer Movement Archives in collaboration with retired Kansas State professor Richard Morse, who received a MAC Presidents' Award in 1996. Crawford served on the Kansas Historical Records Advisory Board for over 20 years. Prior to arriving at Kansas State, he was archivist of the George C. Marshall Research Library, Lexington, Virginia, and director of library and archives at the Missouri Historical Society in St. Louis. He joined SAA in 1973 and became a charter member of the Academy of Certified Archivists. Tony Crawford has been a member of MAC for 34 years.

Edna Fugate, CA, who serves as the archivist for the University of Pikeville, obtained certification through the Academy of Certified Archivists.

Robin Heise has been promoted to records manager/archivist at the Greene County Records Center and Archives in Xenia, Ohio. Heise joined the archives' staff in 2012 as a part-time employee and later moved to a full-time position as the public outreach coordinator.

Lynn Moulton joined Northern Kentucky University this fall as the political papers processing archivist. This position is currently dedicated to processing the papers of former US senator James "Jim" Bunning. Previously, Moulton was a project archivist for History Associates Incorporated, working on archival backlogs at Everglades National Park.

Erik Nordberg was recently named director of the Walter P. Reuther Library of Labor and Urban Affairs at Wayne State University in Detroit. Nordberg had previously served as head of the Michigan Technological University Archives and Copper Country Historical Collections and as executive director of the Michigan Humanities Council.

Rick Pifer retired from the Wisconsin Historical Society in January of 2015 after more than 30 years of service to the State of Wisconsin. Pifer, who last served the historical society as the director of reference and public services, will be spending the next year researching and writing a book on World War I and building kayaks.

Lori Schwartz joined the staff of Archives and Special Collections at the University of Nebraska at Omaha as the archivist for the US senator Chuck Hagel Archives in January. Schwartz previously worked at South Carolina Political Collections, part of the University of South Carolina Libraries.
