Each of the nine meetings also is a convenient way to obtain continuing education units for Certified Crop Advisers, as well as recertification for commercial ag pesticide applicators in categories 1A, 1B, 1C, and 10 for 2007.

The registration fee is \$40 for each location until seven days before the meeting date. Late registration or registration at the door is \$60. There is an additional \$10 fee for those needing applicator recertification credits.
